NAPE's mission is to build educators' capacity to implement effective solutions for increasing student access, educational equity, and workforce diversity. NAPE provides products and services in four key areas: professional development, technical assistance, research and evaluation, and public policy/advocacy.

NETWORKING NAPE provides Affiliate members with access to a network of professionals who exchange ideas and information through dialogue and collective action. NAPE maintains and regularly distributes to members national directories of state and affiliate members.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT Affiliate members receive a reduced registration fee to NAPE's Professional Development Institute (PDI) held near Washington, D.C., each year. Additionally, affiliate members receive priority when requesting professional development from NAPE's suite of programs for administrators, educators, and counselors: Program Improvement Process for Equity™, Micromessaging to Reach and Teach Every Student™, and Focus on Counselors Initiative.

VIRTUAL LEARNING COMMUNITY NAPE uses technology to connect and inform equity advocates across the country. Through NAPE's website, webinars, e-newsletters, and social media, affiliate members are kept up-to-date on equity-related issues, research, publications, events, promising practices, and more.

RESOURCE CLEARINGHOUSE NAPE is known across the nation as the best clearinghouse for equity-related resources. Affiliate members have access to the members-only sections of the NAPE website, which includes a searchable database of more than 800 resources. There is no limit to the number of employees within an affiliate member organization who can have access to the members-only sections.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE NAPE's expert staff provides technical assistance to affiliate members via phone, email, and onsite visits. Affiliate members can contact the national office for customized, just-in-time support for their equity needs.

RESEARCH AND EVALUATION NAPE regularly conducts research and evaluation on topics of interest, such as promising practices, public policy, and accountability—alone or with national coalition partners—and shares the results with affiliate members.

TIMELY FEDERAL POLICY ALERTS NAPE tracks legislation and administrative actions that impact—or have the potential to impact—access, equity, and diversity in classrooms and the workplace. Affiliate members receive timely alerts and updates about public policy activity and suggestions for actions to take to impact the decision-making process.

NATIONAL ADVOCACY NAPE provides a voice in Washington, D.C., for its affiliate members through regular communication and advocacy with Congress and the Administration about issues, policy, and legislation related to equity in education and workforce development.

ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP NAPE encourages its affiliate members to provide input into the development of NAPE's annual Program of Work and to serve on the NAPE Executive Committee and its subcommittees, which are valuable ways to build a stronger organization that works for its members.
