Career and Technical Education in Indiana

Secondary CTE is delivered through comprehensive high schools and area career centers. Postsecondary CTE is delivered through the statewide community college system Ivy Tech, which has 14 regions that include 32 campuses, Vincennes University, and through 4-year programs in many CTE pathways at certain universities.¹



Seven of the 16 career clusters in CTE lead to high-skill, high-wage, and high-demand STEM-related careers (Agriculture, Architecture, Health, Information Technology, Manufacturing, STEM, and Transportation, Distribution, and Logistics) and contain programs that prepare students for nontraditional careers.²
