Michele A. Evans is Vice President and General Manager of the Mission Systems and Training (MST) Undersea Systems line of business for Lockheed Martin Corporation. In this capacity, she leads the development of next-generation undersea warfare systems, unmanned underwater vehicles, acoustic training, ruggedized computing, and command, control, communication, and network systems. Her responsibilities extend to international customers in more than 15 countries through a combination of foreign military and direct commercial sales. Undersea Systems employs more than 2,000 people in ten locations, including Manassas, Virginia; Syracuse, New York; Mitchel Field, New York; Palm Beach, Florida; San Diego, California; Marion, Massachusetts; Juarez, Mexico and Dandenong, Australia.

Ms. Evans also serves as General Manager for the MST Manassas, Virginia facility. In this role, she is the site leader responsible for ensuring success for all MST lines of business and functions resident at the 1,200-employee location.

Previously, Ms. Evans was Vice President, Business Development and Strategy for Lockheed Martin's MST business area and the Mission Systems and Sensors (MS2) Ship and Aviation Systems line of business. In these roles, Ms. Evans was responsible for strategy, new business development and sales, resource investments, and managing relationships with global customers.

Ms. Evans has more than twenty five years of experience in the defense industry having served as the Vice President of the Modernization and Sustainment line of business at Lockheed Martin Systems Integration (LMSI) – Owego; Vice President VH-71 Program; Director Large Scale Processor Programs with both domestic and international customers. She also has held operations, sourcing and finance positions. Ms. Evans served as the chairman of the Board of Directors for the Maritime Helicopter Support Company, a joint venture between Lockheed Martin and Sikorsky to support Maritime H-60 logistics worldwide. Ms. Evans currently serves on the Lockheed Martin Corporate board - LMUK Holdings based in the United Kingdom.
