### Career and Technical Education in Rhode Island

At the secondary level, CTE is delivered through comprehensive high schools and regional career and technical centers. At the postsecondary level, CTE is delivered by the four campuses of the Community College of Rhode Island (CCRI).<sup>1</sup>

### Perkins Performance Indicators (FY 2016)

Congress made accountability for results a central focus of Perkins IV. States are required to report annually on the following core performance indicators, which assess their effectiveness in achieving statewide progress in CTE and optimizing the return on investment of federal funds in CTE.<sup>2</sup>

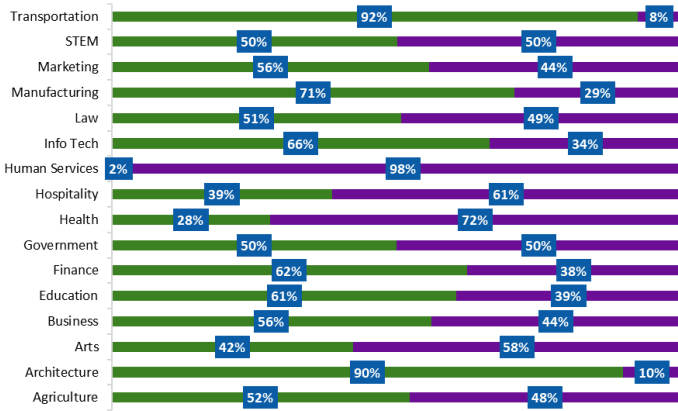

## Career Cluster Enrollment (FY 2016)

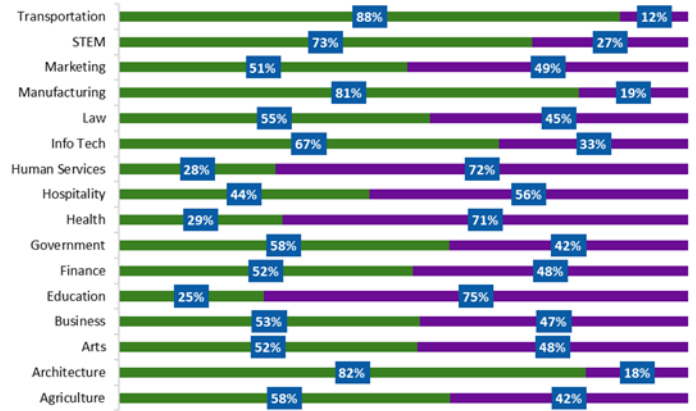

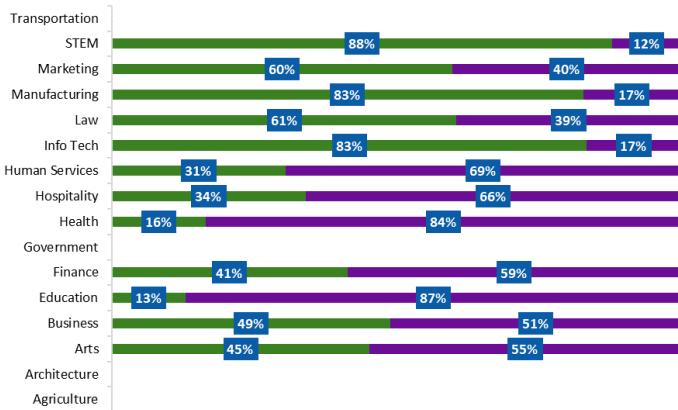
*RI Secondary Enrollment*



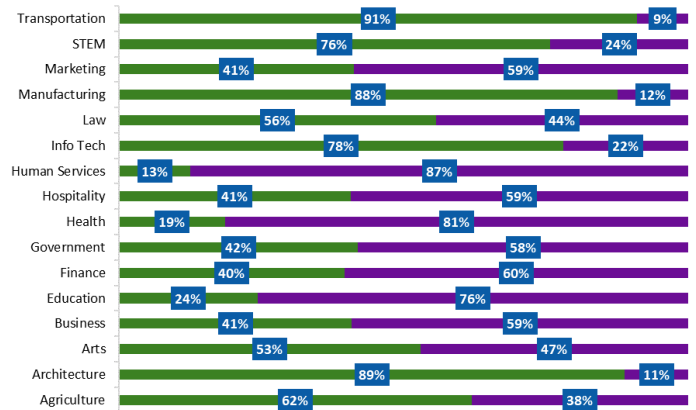
*U.S. Secondary Enrollment*
